



On Saturday 03/12/2016 at 09:49 AM Officers from Southern Regional Police were dispatched to the York County Rail Trail behind the Rail Trail Tavern on Valley St. in Glen Rock Borough for a theft report. Two male subjects were observed removing items from backpacks and left on foot walking south on the rail trail. Officers investigated and learned that a wallet and two cellular phones were stolen from the backpacks. The wallet was found in a creek near the theft location. Officers located video surveillance from a nearby business and confirmed with witnesses that the subjects in the video were the suspects. At 11:30 am an Officer from Southern Regional Police located the two suspects walking in Glen Rock and took them into custody, one with brief resistance.

Arrested was Creag Allen JOHNSON, age 29, for theft, receiving stolen property, possession of small amount of marijuana, and possession of drug paraphernalia. JOHNSON recently returned to York Co. from Colorado and Florida. He had active probation violation warrants out of York Co, PA for DUI and Baltimore Co. Maryland for second degree assault. The two cellular phones were recovered by police hidden under rocks.

Charges are pending against a second male who is 18 years old.
